Thank you for your interest in the Dinkytown Farmers Market. Let me give you a little background and information about this opportunity.

University Lutheran Church of Hope is located in the heart of Dinkytown, and our relationship with the campus community has opened our eyes to an often-overlooked concern for college students: food insecurity. A recent article in the Washington Post suggested that nearly 36% of college students do not get enough to eat. At the University of MN, efforts have been taken to address this, including the launch of the Nutritious U Food Pantry and other community efforts.

Our goal with the Dinkytown Farmers Market is to ensure that students and residents in the Dinkytown, Como, and Marcy Holmes neighborhoods have access to fresh, affordable, and local produce, to support local farmers, and to build community around local sustainable agriculture and food!

Our anticipated launch date is June 13th, 2018. We will run on Wednesdays from 4pm-8pm. We will also have completed an outdoor brick oven for bread and pizza making! We envision a market with a casual and friendly atmosphere and low pressure. Because our mission is to serve the neighborhood and support local farmers, we will not charge vendor fees at this time.
