During this time of COVID, we're adjusting how we share Communion to take greater care. Follow the directions in the bulletin and the presiding minister. Know that we will always offer a gluten-free option for the bread, as well as both wine and grape juice. If you prefer, simply come forward for a blessing. All are welcome at Christ's table.

## Accessible restrooms and diaper changing tables

Women's and men's accessible restrooms are located on both levels of the education wing along the west side of the building. An elevator at the parking lot entrance will take you to either the upper or lower level. Changing tables are located in the gender neutral restrooms near Fellowship Hall on the lower level, in the women's restroom on the upper level, and in the nursery on the upper level. Another gender neutral restroom is by the lounge.

## Fellowship

During this season of COVID we savor fellowship whenever and wherever we can! While we're not serving coffee and treats, we are gathering outdoors on the patio and in the courtyard.

## Sanctuary
